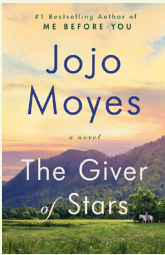


“GROW” IT

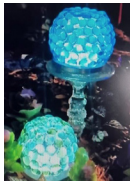

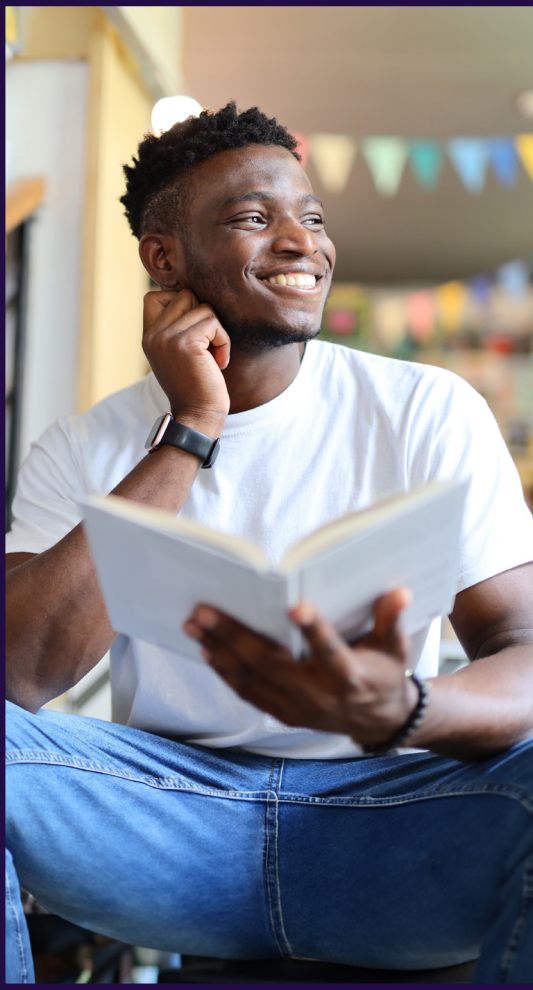
